Preliminary Business

Next Meeting: Wednesday, July 10, 2024, following 6:45 p.m. worship service. Devotions: Lisa Miller Communion Assistants: Wednesday, June 19 - Greg Freitag and Wednesday, July 10 - Wayne Krump. Secretary's Report - Approved Treasurer's Report - Approved

Pastor's Report – Pastor shared that the confirmation students had a celebration to put closure on the year. LYO is planning to serve dinner prior to one of the Wednesday evening worship services. The group attending the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans from July 15 - 21 met and discussed their covenant. Allison Smith will be representing our congregation at the Synod worship service while there. The group has met their fundraising goal. The food trucks on Tuesday evenings continue to be very well received and Pastor has met many new people and received lots of gratitude for Faith Lutheran hosting food trucks. There will be a "send off" to the group traveling to New Orleans during the July 10 worship service. Pastor will assist LeRoy and Rose Turner as they renew their wedding vows to celebrate their 25th wedding anniversary on June 29. He will lead a memorial service for the Calice Carriere family at 1 p.m. on July 27th. There will be a private burial service at the Salem Cemetery followed by fellowship in the church basement.

Committee Reports & Assignments

Education & LYO - Lisa Miller - Plans for holding VBS in August are underway.

Property & Maintenance - Keith Kragerud & Wayne Krump - The basement bathroom door is locking properly. One bank of lights in Pastor's office is fixed and two more will be fixed in the near future. Keith will get an estimate to replace the urinal in the men's bathroom. The water collecting along the concrete seam in the basement under the lift is being addressed.

Faith Forward – Pastor Devlyn Brooks – The committee met on May 19 following worship. LaDawn Turner shared a document that captured the outreach we're currently doing as a congregation. The group will receive that document and another that they can share suggested activities on via email prior to the next meeting. Pastor Brooks and Sara Aigner created a draft of a checklist that can be used when coordinating a committee activity. They will also create an evaluation form the committee leader or members can complete at the end of the event. A few members of the commit-

tee met with the Wolverton City Council and discussed opportunities for collaboration. LaDawn and Renata Smeby shared the news of the mobile sign they purchased. Jessica Nelson shared plans for a City of Wolverton picnic with kids games sponsored by City Council and Faith Forward/ Faith Lutheran on June 13. Bob Stein updated the group on the work he's accomplished, and next steps he'll take, as he looks at Faith Lutheran's A/V needs. They will meet again on June 18 at 7 p.m.

Old Business

Pastor's Job Description – Lisa distributed the job description created and approved in 2021 to the Council prior to the meeting. Council members asked Pastor if he is truly working at a 50% capacity. He shared that his hours exceed half time. Discussion was held to gain a greater understanding of the church seasons and activities that require the majority of his time. His current job description and potential modifications to it, as well as requirements of the Council, will be discussed at the July 10th meeting. Pastor Brooks and the Council will also discuss their performances and the duties the Council could potentially take on to support Pastor's half time position. The group will come to the meeting prepared with creative strategies on how to address the issues associated with Pastor investing additional time in his half time position.

Other Old Business

JAM Enterprises, Breckenridge, MN, did a beautiful job cleaning the carpet in high traffic areas, as well as professionally cleaning the kitchen floor and 24 of the dining room chairs.

New Business

LaDawn Turner and Renata Smeby purchased a used outdoor sign and letters that can be utilized for featuring food truck information as well as other "Faith Forward" and City of Wolverton initiatives. The sign will be placed on wheels. Council made and approved a motion to reimburse LaDawn and Renata \$663.67 for the mobile sign and its improvements.

Pastor Brooks received a very kind thank you from Mildred Peterson for the celebration held on May 5 when dedicating the cross the Peterson family gave in memory of her husband, Pastor Ted Peterson.

Pastor's Report – Pastor renewed LeRoy and Rose Turner's vows to celebrate their 25th wedding anniversary on June 29. He will be out July 15-21 attending the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans. The Synod office will assist with emergency calls if necessary. He will lead a memorial service for the Calice Carriere family at 1 p.m. on July 27th. There will be a private burial service at the Salem Cemetery followed by fellowship in the church basement. September 8 is Rally Sunday. Devlyn will be at the fall Theological event September 15-17. Pastor shared that he interviewed for, and was offered, a part time position with the Northwest Minnesota Synod. He will oversee 62 individuals in the SAM program. He will also assist with the Synod's fundraising efforts. The new position began on July 1. He also started his own company called Mustard Seed Media, LLC. He will be available to organizations in need of freelance writing and marketing support. The Council wished Pastor Brooks well in these new ventures.

Committee Reports & Assignments

Education & LÝO - Lisa Miller – The youth will be in New Orleans July 15-21. Plans for VBS are in motion. Endowment - Duane Nelson - No report. Faith Women - Sara Aigner - No report. Men's Group - Wayne Krump - No report. Music & Worship - Tina Aigner - No report. Property & Maintenance - Keith Kragerud & Wayne Krump – The choir loft floor has not been refinished yet. Lisa will follow up on this. The air conditioners need servicing. The toilet paper dispenser in the mens' bathroom needs attention. The committee is continuing to look at purchasing a new urinal. The sanctuary ceiling and wall has stains that need attention (these are not new stains).

Faith Forward – Pastor Devlyn Brooks – The committee met on June 18. There was great discussion and more plans are in place for upcoming events. There were approximately 60 people in attendance for the July 7 evening event featuring Pastor Brooks and Todd Holdman. The food trucks continue to be a success within the community and with the vendors. The next meeting is July 30 at 7 p.m.

Old Business

Pastor's Job Description - Lisa distributed the job descrip-

tion created and

approved in 2021 to the Council and Pastor Brooks prior to the meeting. All in attendance felt the position description looked good, but there were some things uncovered as we discussed the amount of time that Pastor is dedicating to our church. The reality is that he is giving us 75% time, not the 50% agreed upon in 2021. An example of how the time is increased is during the Lenten season. There are 15 services to prepare for, and that was not identified at the onset of Devlyn's position at Faith Lutheran. Other examples of his time investment were discussed. If given more time, Pastor Brooks would like to assist in the revival of the Men's Club and an adult bible study or text study if that would be of interest to the congregation. He is actively exploring ideas that will help bring people back to Faith Lutheran.

The Council help a lengthy discussion regarding the importance of having a retention plan in place to keep Pastor Brooks. We are in need of leadership at this time.

Each member of Council, Pastor Brooks and the Mutual Ministry committee (Ross Aigner, Deb Byars and Jean Aigner) will complete a performance review for Pastor with a deadline of August 1. Lisa will compile the information and it will be shared with him at the August 7 meeting. Now that Council identified that Pastor Brooks is working more than at a 50% capacity, a motion was made "to give Pastor Devlyn Brooks a \$20,000 bonus for 2024 to recognize that he is actually working a 75% position, not a 50% position. We are grateful to Devlyn for helping us shape our future." The motion received a second and passed unanimously.

The money for the bonus is available in the Mission Investment Fund.

A discussion about Devlyn continuing as a half time pastor or having his position adjusted will take place at the annual meeting. Our congregation needs to participate in a conversation about who we want to be and what we want for the future of our congregation.

New Business

In an effort to support our new neighbor, The Red Silo, it was suggested the congregational meals prior to Wednesday evening services will cease, and members will be encouraged via e-mail and social media to support the food truck in Wolverton on Wednesdays instead. People are welcome to enjoy their meals in the church basement if they'd like.

Tim Nicklay and LaDawn Turner and Renata Smeby offered to host the August 21 outdoor worship service at the Turner Gravel Pit. They will provide dinner. Renewing baptisms for those interested was discussed.

The Synod has a "Harvest Blessings Box" available to congregations for \$50. It has tools for worship and events that can be held this fall. It fits with our Faith Forward initiatives nicely. Council agreed to purchase the materials.
