

Pastor's Report:

Pastor reported that September was a busy month with lots of excitement. The LYO kids did a great job of providing an overview of the Youth Gathering in New Orleans during worship on September 29. Confirmation kicked off October 2 with a student/parent meeting. We have three students attending the middle school retreat on November 22. The Mutual Ministry group will be on pause through the conclusion of harvest. Pastor graduates from "First Call" on October 21. The Red Silo is holding a "Pumpkin Palooza" on October 5, and our Sunday School is assisting. Pastor will speak at the Lake Park/Audubon Conference 4 WELCA Gathering on Oct 19. Red Silo's "Pickled Fest" was well attended. October is proving to be another busy month!

Committee Reports & Assignments

Education & Youth - Lisa Miller - The Sunday School will host a community movie night on October 25. Faith Women - Sara Aigner - Faith Women will meet on October 13 following worship. Quilting dates are October 15, 16 and 22. Trunk or Treat is October 31.

Property & Maintenance - Keith Kragerud & Dike Krump - Quotes for a new urinal are anticipated to arrive soon. The floor in the men's restroom needs replacing. More discussion on how to paint the damaged area of the sanctuary ceiling was held. Does anyone know of a business to contact for quotes? It was suggested the property and maintenance committee meet about these projects after harvest.

Faith Forward - A meeting was held September 22 after worship. The "Harvest Box" made available by our Synod had great ideas. The Sunday School is spearheading the efforts to provide local farmers and agriculture workers with sack lunches this fall. The date is to be determined. They will target trucks in line at CW. More details will evolve at the next meeting which is October 20 after worship. The congregation will have an opportunity to participate.
